

Esoffflow finishes training of 1st batch in CSR project

After three and half month of training, students joining the first batch of the Danida funded pilot project on vocational training and job creation for ex-prostitutes and recovering drug users, completed their training.

The students have been trained in technical skills as well as soft skills and English. Out of 24 students joining the course 16 students completed the training.



A ceremony was held on 13 July to celebrate the successful completion of the first of eight batches. Managing Director of Esoffflow, Thomas Frisenberg, handed over the certificates to the students.

The best students from the first batch will now be offered jobs at Esoffflow as part of the job creation effort. It is expected that 3-5 of the students will be able to join the Esoffflow team in the coming months.

Students expressed their eagerness to start working with Esoffflow and to return to their families and start a new life.
